In IPC we went for a walk around the local area with our iPads, taking photographs of local plants and trees which we then annotated. We carried out an experiment to see which conditions are best suited to germinating and growing plants and we also dissected some flowers. We also studied the wonderful benefits bees bring to the world and made posters informing people why it's so important to stop these precious creatures from population decline.
