

KICKSTARTING TERM 3

We have started exploring a new unit called 'How Humans Work.' We began with a Knowledge Harvest on major organs to share what we already know, what we are uncertain about, and what is unfamiliar. Currently, we are focusing on the eyes, learning about how we see, and crafting our own eye models with ping-pong balls.











Year 4 began this term with a literacy unit based on the rainforest. They read two wonderful books by Lynn Cherry called The Great Kapok Tree and The Shaman's Apprentice, which provided the inspiration for their own rainforest stories. They are currently enjoying a unit about Mermaids, so far they have read Selkie by Gillian McClure and Can You Catch a Mermaid by Jane Ray which will lead on to the creation of their own imaginative stories. In Maths, our focus is finding common factors, prime numbers, square and cube numbers, and multiplying and dividing up to 4-digit numbers. Additionally, we are learning about drawing and interpreting pictograms and bar graphs.



In Literacy, we have relished reading books by Anthony Browne—clever, fun, and imaginative! Our top pick from the five books we've read is "Willy the Dreamer," which got a 5-star rating in our review filled with powerful adjectives. We also made our own characters and wrote a script called "The Awful Hat," featuring AB's character Millie. We talked about how to give advice to Millie while paying attention to our punctuation and capitalisation.



It has been very exciting in **Maths**, with the focus on recognising and naming **3d shapes**, making 3d shapes, describing **patterns** and grouping **shapes**.

The unit we are currently on is **fractions**, with many exciting activities including our **Beat the Hippo** fraction game.
